

B.A.S.E APP SETUP GUIDE FOR MEMBERS

Instructions For: Smart Phones / Tablets

STEP #1> (iPhones / iPads)

On your device tap on the Safari icon



STEP #1> (Android)

On your device tap on the Chrome icon

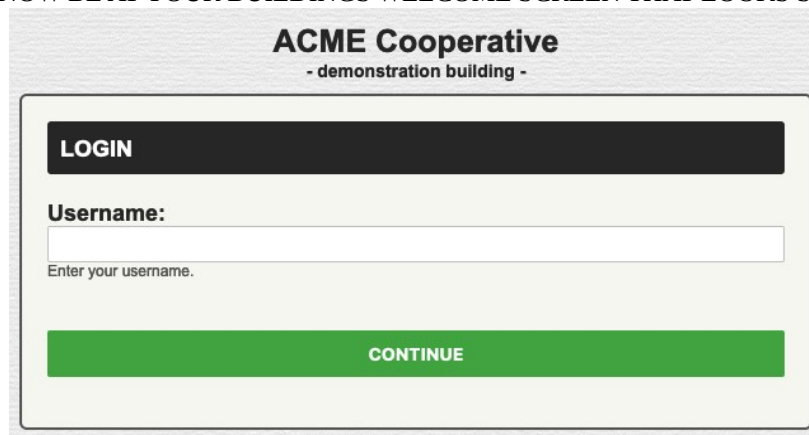


STEP #2>

Place the cursor in the top/bottom URL bar (*not the search box in the middle*) type the following:

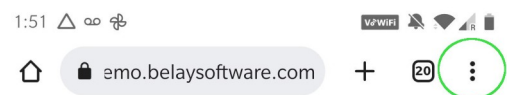
STEP #3>

Now you should see a menu bar at the top or bottom of your screen that looks similar the one below. tap on the item circled in green for your specific device:

iPhone / iPad devices



Android devices



STEP #4>

Select the option that says something similar to 'Add to Home Screen' (you may have to scroll down or to the left/right to find it, or it could be under 'MORE...')

STEP #5>

If prompted, tap the blue word(s) **Add (iPhone / iPad)** OR **Add Automatically (Android)**

Now return to your main phone/tablet home screen and you should have a new ICON on one of your home screen pages (you may have to swipe to the left or right to find it) of a wrench and a screwdriver (pictured below).

Instructions For: Any desktop or laptop

1> Open the internet browser of your choice (Microsoft Edge, Google Chrome, Safari, Firefox, etc)

2> In the URL bar ***at the top of your screen*** (not the Google, AOL, Yahoo search box) type in the website address listed in STEP #3 above

3> Once the login screen appears save it into your 'Favorites' or 'Bookmarks' section

4> Now in your Favorites/Bookmarks menu you should see the BASE icon of a wrench and a screw driver (pictured below)

HOW TO LOG IN:

In the 'Username' field enter **your unit number**, for most buildings, it's 3 digits like **101** or **205**

In the 'Password' field enter **0987** (this is the default password)

If you wish to change your password contact you management staff or maintenance personnel and the password can only be numbers and must be exactly 4 digits, no more no less

NOTE: some buildings don't use the password feature so you only need your unit # to get access
